Personal Assistants



We are supporting individuals to employ their own personal assistants.

Service users are being supported to develop job adverts, identifying specific skills and attributes.

These are placed in the local community and places where the person enjoy going, for example the local gym or drama group. They are also advertised on the Future Directions website.

Working together with the service user, family and support teams questions are developed for the interview. The service user is then supported to interview the potential candidates.

A three way contract is agreed between the service user, the personal assistant and the service. This is used as part of the job consultation process.
